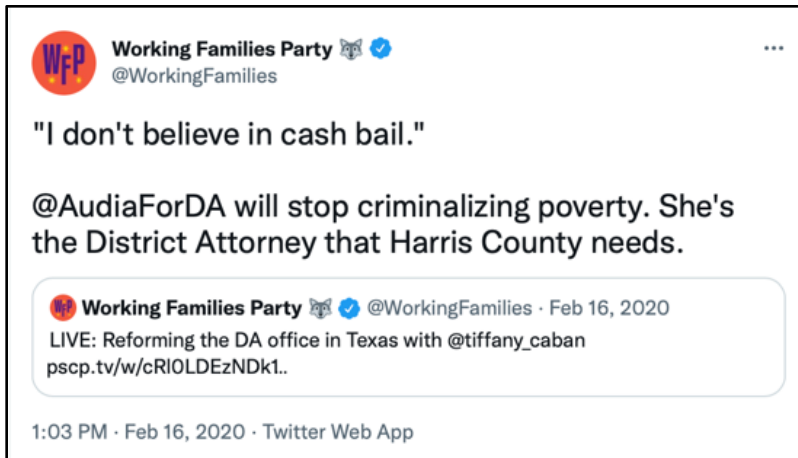

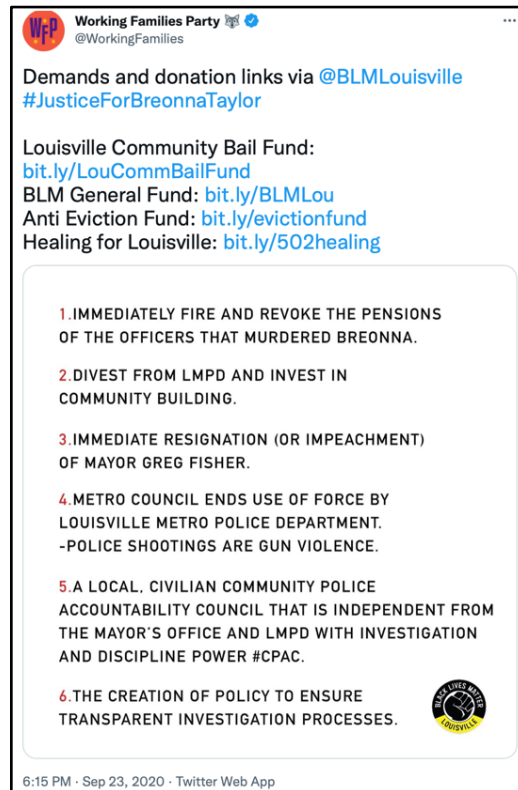

## **Hayes Voted To Allow Washington D.C. To Eliminate Mandatory Minimums And Decrease Punishments For Violent Crimes**

**On Feb. 9, 2023, Hayes Voted Against H.J.R. 26 – Disapproving The Action Of The District Of Columbia Council In Approving The Revised Criminal Code Act.** (Passage On H.J.R 26, [Roll Call Vote #119](#), Passed 250-173-11, Hayes Voted Nay, 2/9/23)

**H.J.R. 26 Nullifies Washington D.C.’s Revised Criminal Code Act Of 2022.** “This joint resolution nullifies the Revised Criminal Code Act of 2022, enacted by the council of the District of Columbia (DC). **Washington D.C.’S Act Eliminates Life Sentences, Gets Rid Of Mandatory Minimums For Every Crime But First-Degree Murder, And Decreases Punishments For Violent**



**Crimes Such As Carjackings, Home Invasion Burglaries, Robberies And Even Homicides.** “Washington could become a more dangerous city if the D.C. Council votes Tuesday, as currently planned, to override Mayor Muriel E. Bowser’s veto of a bill that decreases punishments for violent crimes such as carjackings, home invasion burglaries, robberies and even homicides. The far-reaching rewrite of the criminal code will further tie the hands of police and prosecutors while overwhelming courts. With the capital city awash in handguns, the measure would also scale back penalties for convicted felons illegally carrying firearms, as well as for using them to commit crimes. The bill eliminates life sentences and gets rid of mandatory minimums for every crime but first-degree murder. The *maximum* penalty for someone convicted of a violent felony while using a gun to commit more violence would drop to four years from 15 years. This is not an evidence-based approach to public safety. **Mayor Bowser Vetoed The Bill Over Concerns Regarding The Lower Penalties For Certain Crimes.** Over the past several months, residents and partners in the public safety and criminal justice community expressed concerns about some provisions in the updated code, including lower penalties for certain crimes. The updated code would expand eligibility for the Second Look Act from youthful, convicted violent offenders to people of all ages; it would also expand the right to a jury trial for those charged with misdemeanors but facing jail time, which is expected to exacerbate the already stretched capacity of the court system; and it would reduce maximum criminal penalties for violent crimes like carjacking and robberies.” (Press Release, “Mayor Bowser Announces The Revised Criminal Code Amendment Act Of 2023,” [Office Of Mayor Muriel Bowser](#), 2/6/23)
